Utility Buckets - Universal Fit buckets also referred to as "slip-on-the-forks" forklift attachment buckets. These buckets can be utilized along with whichever model and make of extendable reach lift truck. If your unit is unable to be matched with a quick-tach component, another new or used universal fit bucket could be located instead. Typical universal forklift buckets connect to forks that are up to 6" wide and are 48" long. Bigger fork pockets could be prearranged via an account manager upon request.

Because they slip directly onto the blades, universal fit buckets stay on the machine and are a lot less at risk to destruction. As opposed to the quick-tach container models, universal fit buckets are 50 percent. This additional space makes them ideal for carrying irregular shaped loads like broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls, tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel and moving large debris piles.

Quick-Tach Buckets

Quick-Tach Buckets are constructed for extendable-reach lift trucks. They are built to allow placement of material way beyond the reach of a loader. A hardened beveled cutting blade on both sides and on the leading edge reinforces stability, resistance to wear and tear and offers supreme durability. Quick-Tach forklift buckets are augmented by scuff bars along the bottom of the unit which protect it from abrasion.

Quick-Tach lift buckets can in several cases substitute the blades and carriage of a lift truck, which may weigh somewhere between one hundred to seven hundred pounds. These buckets when set up can free up more load capacity, enabling it to deal with both larger and heavier objects. The Quick-Tach can dump materials more or less 1.5 feet higher due to the shorter depth of its bucket. These buckets are built in a custom fashion in order to suit all the specifications of specific makes and models of lift trucks. It is important to check with a construction equipment specialist in order to find the modified Quick-Tach bucket solution for your requirements.

Lift truck bucket attachments are excellent for ground level work on construction location sites. They are often designed for transporting snow in northern regions, and sand and gravel loading.
