Cascade Clamps - Founded in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company started as a small machine shop employing just four individuals. Total sales for that year amounted to about \$60,000. The first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless-steel valves, pipe fittings and different components. Through 5 years of operation, the business had stretched to 40 employees and their yearly sales volume had increased to three hundred thirty thousand dollars. At present, Cascade is amongst the top global manufacturers within the material handling industry.

Manufacture and design of the company's very first hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive pursuit of better business possibilities. During the last sixty years, the material handling industry has grown into a highly sophisticated field and Cascade has proudly performed a part in this progress. Cascade at the moment continues to develop as the leader provider of forklift attachments and numerous related items. The company feels confident in their potential in order to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding client's requirements in the future and remaining competitive in the world market.

During the nineteen fifties, Cascade began to fabricate, design, and sell its hydraulic attachments. A brand new facility was constructed in 1956, to house all plant operations and offices in Portland, Oregon, which remains to be the company's current headquarters. After 15 years of business, total workers reached one hundred eighty employees and sales had reached practically 2.3 million dollars.

The next production plant was built in the year 1959 in Springfield, Glendale. 1960 marked Cascade's initial transfer into the global world of the material handling industry as the company established interest in the Netherlands, England, and Australia.

In the year 1964, the business changed its name to the Cascade Corporation. Afterward in the year 1965, the business went public with an initial offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Since then the business has expanded its manufacturing facilities throughout the continental USA to the areas Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already present plants in Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Glendale. Cascade merchandise are fabricated internationally due to numerous subsidiary operations. In 1994, a new facility was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European command center. This facility is designed to be the essential customer service centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and the year 1997 subsequent to acquiring five firms, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the global best in forks.
